## AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOLS; REQUIRING EACH LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD AND GOVERNING BODY OF A CHARTER SCHOOL TO DEVELOP OR ADOPT GUIDANCE FOR STUDENT WATER SAFETY; REQUIRING THAT WATER SAFETY GUIDANCE BE PROVIDED TO PARENTS OF EACH STUDENT AT THE BEGINNING OF EACH SCHOOL YEAR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. A new section of the Public School Code is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] PARENTAL GUIDANCE FOR WATER SAFETY. --

Each local school board and governing body of a charter school shall develop or adopt digital or written guidance for parents that promotes student safety in, on and around bodies of water and water infrastructure, including information about local options for age-appropriate swimming .230821.1

lessons and other water safety courses.

Beginning in the 2025-2026 school year, all public schools shall provide the parents of each student with the guidance developed pursuant to Subsection A of this section upon the student's enrollment at a public school or no later than the tenth school day of a school year. The guidance may be conspicuously incorporated into a district-wide or schoolspecific handbook published for parents and students; provided that the public school receives written acknowledgment of a parent's receipt of the handbook."
