BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 13-1-128 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1984, Chapter 65, Section 101, as amended) is amended to read:

"13-1-128. SOLE SOURCE AND EMERGENCY PROCUREMENTS --PUBLICATION OF AWARD TO AGENCY [WEB SITE] WEBSITE AND SUNSHINE PORTAL--CONTENT AND SUBMISSION OF RECORD.--

- Prior to award of a sole source procurement Α. contract, the state purchasing agent or central purchasing office shall:
- provide the information described in (1) Subsection E of this section to the department of information .229768.1
