AN ACT

RELATING TO GAMING; REQUIRING THAT GAMING MACHINES MEET THE
STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS OF STATE LAWS AND RULES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 60-2E-44 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1997,
Chapter 190, Section 46, as amended) is amended to read:

"60-2E-44. MACHINE SPECIFICATIONS.--To be eligible for
licensure, each gaming machine shall meet all specifications
established by rules of the board and:

A. be unable to be manipulated in a manner that
affects the random probability of winning plays or in any
other manner determined by the board to be undesirable;

B. have at least one mechanism that accepts coins
or currency;

C. be capable of having play suspended through the
central system by the executive director until the executive
director resets the gaming machine;

D. have electronic meters within a readily
accessible locked area of the gaming machine that maintain a
record of all money inserted into the machine, all cash
payouts of winnings, all refunds of winnings, all credits
played for additional games and all credits won by players;

E. be capable of printing out, at the request of
the executive director, readings on the electronic meters of
