 - Prescription Drug/Opioid Overdose Grant (focus is on layperson distribution): \$1 million a year for 5 years in Bernalillo, Dona Ana, Rio Arriba, and Santa Fe Counties
 - Opioid-State Targeted Response Grant (focus is on distributing to first responders): \$4.8 million a year for 2 years for all 33 counties
