

OUR PROGRAMS

Our continuum of care model allows us to meet the individual needs of clients, reduce the chance of relapse and support longterm recovery through evidence-based and culturally-sensitive treatment.



Medically Monitored Detox

Safe, monitored and managed treatment to help clients through the acute physiological and psychological effects of withdrawal.



Outpatient Treatment

Highly-structured regular and intensive programs help clients develop resiliency, establish healthy routines, learn coping skills, and acquire a recovery network for ongoing support.



Residential Treatment

30- and 90-day programs for men and women to focus solely on their recovery while developing the skills and resources needed to create a solid foundation for success.



Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT)

An individually-tailored program of medication and behavioral therapy, this approach has been shown to sustain recovery, reduce opioid overdose and help clients lead a self-directed life.



Case Managment

All clients are assigned a case manager at admission who works with them throughout their recovery providing support for healthcare services, housing options, transportation assistance, and other supportive resources in the community.





Client Demographic Information FY2022

Over the past year, the Recovery Center served

29% more clients

than the previous year across all programs through a focus on expansion, innovation and community outreach & collaboration.

The Recovery Center at a Glance



3,497 admissions across all programs



45% of clients enter residential treatment from detox



Of the clients who went through SFRC residential programs, 83% remained in recovery/were not actively using drugs or alcohol at 6 months, 87% had housing, & 57% were employed



36% of clients report being unhoused



79% of clients are Medicaid recipients

EXPANSION

We are committed to strategic growth, expansion and innovation to meet the significant need for behavioral health and substance use disorder treatment in the region.

RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM EXPANSION

Expands gender - specific residential programs, adds 90-day extended treatment and establishes sober living Bridge Housing.

TELEHEALTH EXPANSION

Upgrades telehealth services to support clients who have limited resources for travel, lack of access to medical providers who offer MAT, live in rural areas or simply don't have the capacity to attend in-person therapy or groups.

FOUR CORNERS DETOX RECOVERY CENTER OPENS

In response to a request from NM DoH and NM HSD, Santa Fe Recovery Center opens Four Corners Detox Recovery Center in Gallup offering medically managed detoxification services.

STREET OUTREACH & RESIDENTIAL

With a grant from HRSA, SFRC launches its street outreach program to provide case management, referrals and harm reduction.

FCDRC adds 30-day residential treatment including culturally proficient treatment options.

GROW TH IN GALLUP

FCDRC adds outpatient services and programming for families and concerned significant others to empower them to set boundaries, communicate effectively and improve their quality of life.



Bridge Houses

- 40% of clients experiencing homelessness
- Total of five Bridge Houses
- Two houses added FY2022 one for women and one for women and their children
