Statewide coalition that engages with our members by assisting them funding, data, training, navigation

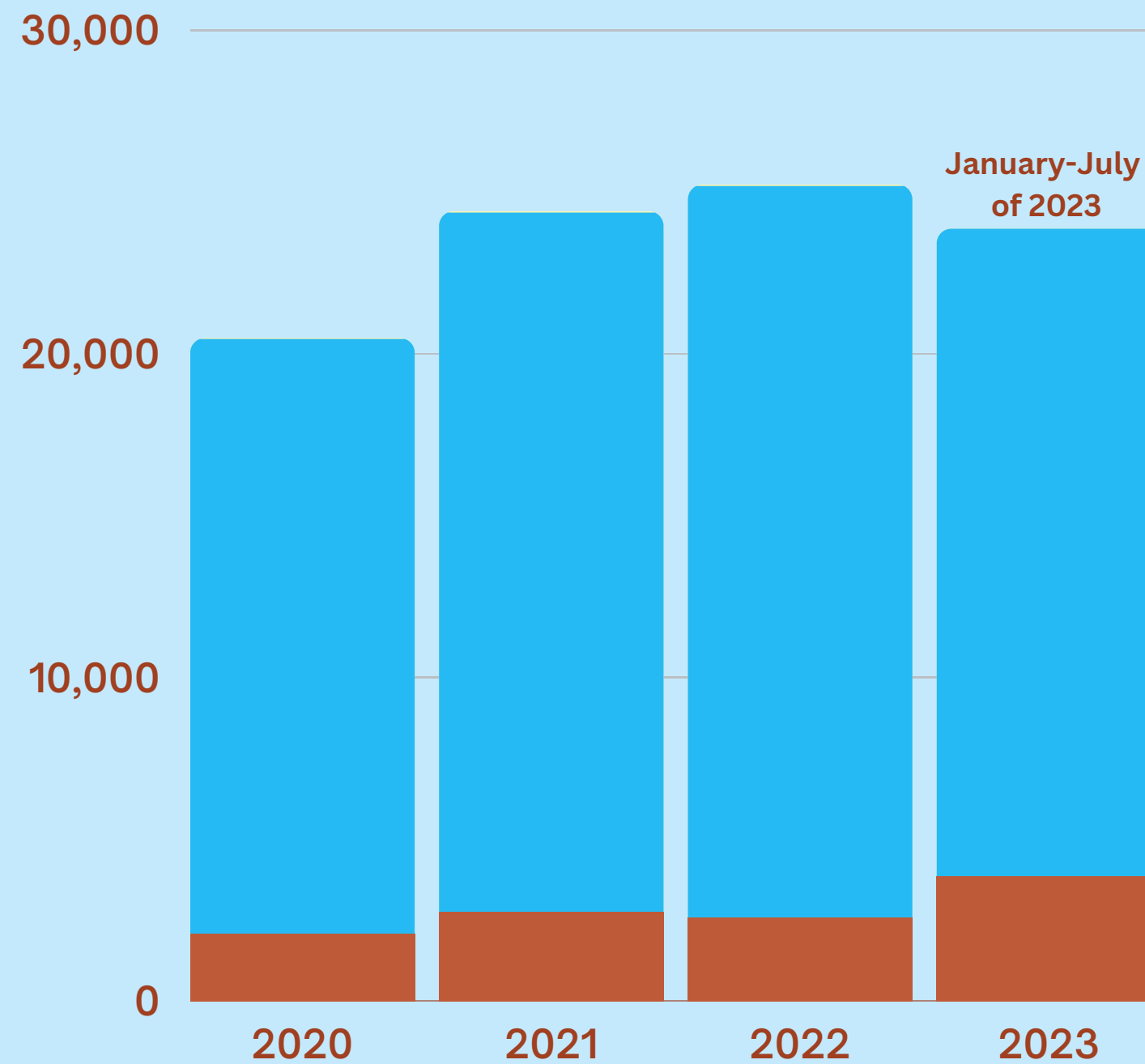

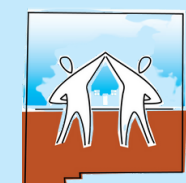

- Point in Time (PIT) Count is required by HUD for all CoCs
- PIT Count is a significant under count of individuals experiencing homelessness

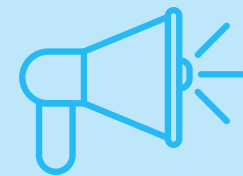

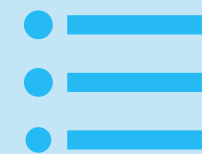


Systematic Approach
