### Over the past year ARC's work on the Statewide Inventory has focused on two work efforts:

- Ongoing efforts to update to the Statewide Inventory
  - Reviews for non-GSD purview agencies (most have been reviewed and updated).
  - Monthly updates to GSD-purview agency changes
  - Reconciling space assignments to reflect current space usage resulting from lease consolidation activities and agency renaming and reorganizations

# Inventory Update



### **Statewide Inventory (continued):**

- Expanding the Statewide Inventory to include the holdings of the State's Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) in cooperation with HED
  - Compilation of facility holdings for all 31 of the State's HEIs reflecting a combination of data reported to HED by the HEI's, and data from various HEI's master plans
  - 21 HEI's have reviewed their data and provided corrections
  - Efforts continue to validate the data for the remaining 10 HEI's
  - Future plan is to work in cooperation with HED and the individual HEI's to complete periodic reviews and updates to the Higher Education inventory data
