## RESOLUTION OF TSE'II'AHII' CHAPTER

TSEII.0724.0701

Requesting the New Mexico Indian Affairs Committee to fund \$9,300,000 to plan, design & construct the Navajo Gallup Water Supply Project (NGWSP) Regional Supply & Distribution Water Lines; Becon-Bisti-N9(BBN9), Cutter Lateral 371/I-40 Corridor Project which will provide critical water supply to the community (Residence, Business, Economic Development and School, ect.). BBN9 is a multi-phased regional project that will serve approximately (Coyote Canyon, Tse'ii'ahi', Nahodishgish, Crownpoint, Becenti, Lake Valley, WhiteRock, Littlewater, Casamero Lake, Baca/Prewitt, Thoreau) twelve chapters.

### WHEREAS:

1. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section I (B) Tse'ii'ahi' Chapter is vested with the authority to review all matters affecting the community and to make appropriate correction when necessary and make recommendation to the Navajo Nation and other local agencies for appropriate action; and
2. Tse'ii'ahi' Chapter is responsible for the safety, health, and welfare of the chapter members; and
3. The Tse'ii'ahi' Chapter membership is desirous of enhancing the living standards and providing healthy environment for residents living in the community of Tse'ii'ahi' Chapter, Navajo Nation; and
4. Tse'ii'ahi' Chapter is in need of a sustainable water source; and
5. Tse'ii'ahi' Chapter is working together with surrounding chapters on a regional water project that will provide a sustainable, long-term water supply source for the chapters of Coyote Canyon, Tse'ii'ahi', Nahodishgish, Crownpoint, Little Water, Becenti, White Rock, and Lake Valley; and
6. Navajo Nation Department of Water Resources has already or will complete all the necessary consents required, environmental and cultural resources inventories and obtain clearances for the proposed undertaking; and
7. The preliminary estimate of budget needed to plan, design & construct water system improvements for the NGWSP BBN9 project is \$9,600,000.
