



## Statutory/Rule Amendments NOTE: NOT A JUDICIARY BILL

**Focus: Criminal Competency Statute** 

#### **Options for Diversion to Treatment and Services**

- All parties agree that law enforcement diversion and other pre-prosecution diversion would be beneficial and would be good alternatives <u>in addition to</u> court diversion
- PRIOR TO determination of competency: Diversion or AOT prior to competency evaluation ordered and shortly after arrest
- AFTER defendant found incompetent: Diversion or AOT instead of competency restoration

## Statutory/Rule Amendments (Con't)

### **Focus: Criminal Competency Statute**

#### **Alternatives for Competency Restoration**

- AFTER defendant found incompetent and court determines they need to be restored (Note: Restoration is not treatment as we commonly think of it.)
- Alternatives to NMBHI would be:
  - outpatient competency restoration
  - residential competency restoration
  - a combination of restoration services

• Shorten amount of time for competency restoration if at NMBHI
