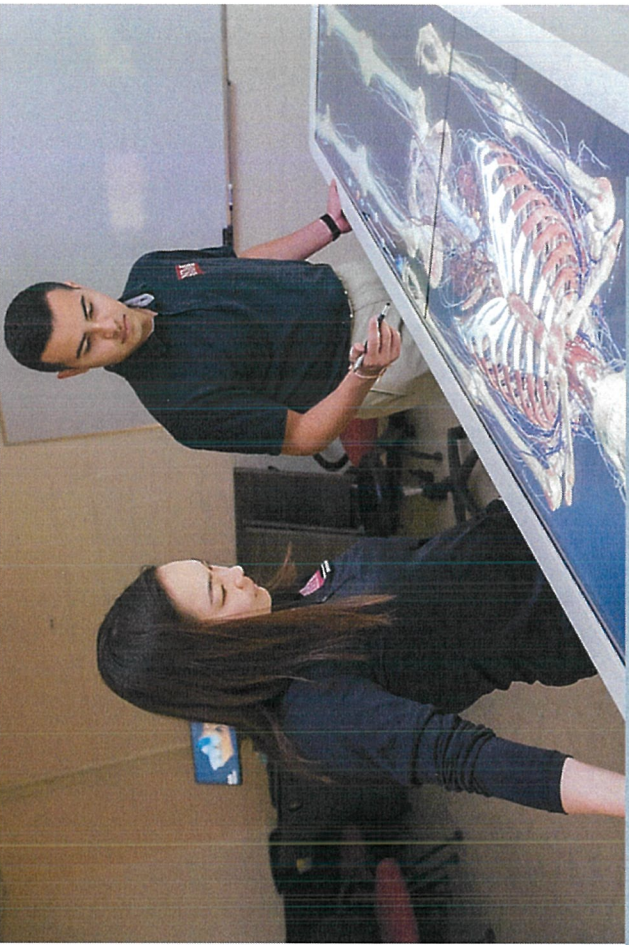

- Serves the mental health needs of NMSU students
 - Individual Counseling
 - Group Counseling
 - Outcomes Research to advance the field
- Broader impact via in person and telehealth services
- Seeking funding to expand services to larger local, regional, and statewide community to include children and adolescents and addition of assessment services

- **Instructional Mission:**
 - Speech-Language Pathologists work with clients across the lifespan affected by speech, language, hearing, cognitive, and swallowing disorders
 - Currently about 140 undergraduate students and about 40 graduate students are trained in the field of Speech-Language Pathology
- **Outreach Mission:**
 - ***Papen Apendamos Autism Diagnostic Center***
 - One of two interdisciplinary Autism Diagnostic Centers in NM and currently the only center in NM to accept new referrals for clients older than 2 years and the only center to provide adult diagnostic services
 - Serves about 200 families annually
 - ***Edgar R. Garrett Speech and Hearing Center***
 - Training Clinic for our graduate students
 - Providing about 1,402 treatment sessions annually to clients from Las Cruces and surrounding areas
