

Narrative Shift Partnership

Since March 2019, Generation Justice (GJ) has led the Narrative Shift Partnership (NSP) with youth-serving organizations, content, and policy experts. The purpose of the NSP is to shift the dominant negative narrative about youth in New Mexico to a narrative that uplifts the value that youth leaders bring and the importance of investing in our New Mexican youth. The NSP will be an ongoing partnership with the goal of building a network of organizations, experts, and youth leaders to work together towards policy, narrative, and campaigns to shift the narrative on youth in New Mexico.

Brad Louis (17) Santa Fe Indian School Leadership Institute

• Invest in young people through programs that address the low levels of academic achievement and strengthen building better relationships across cultures.

Barbara Ramirez (22) Generation Justice

- More funding for the health care systems that are already in place including Medicare and Medicaid.
- Speak with colleague legislators about the importance of addressing the underfunded healthcare system in New Mexico.

Saygen Ruvalcaba (23) New Mexico Dream Team

Place laws that will help and protect our immigrant communities in New Mexico regardless
of decisions taken at the national level, similar to reproductive rights laws that have been
passed. New Mexico can be a leader nationally in this way.
