

- District and School Support and Readiness Assessments
- School Improvement Performance Coach
- Professional Learning for district and school teams, grounded in common themes of the findings of the readiness assessment
- Grant funding to support evidence-based interventions

Plan Moving Forward

- Host Regional Meetings. PED will host regional meetings to talk about the accountability model and our Differentiated Systems of Support over the next 2 months.
- **Create Advisory Group.** We are creating a Data Accountability Working and Advisory Group moving forward.
- Award Funding. Award by July 1, 2023.
- **Support Schools.** In order to meet the tight timeline for allocation and spend, PED staff will be supporting schools to deploy the resources.
