

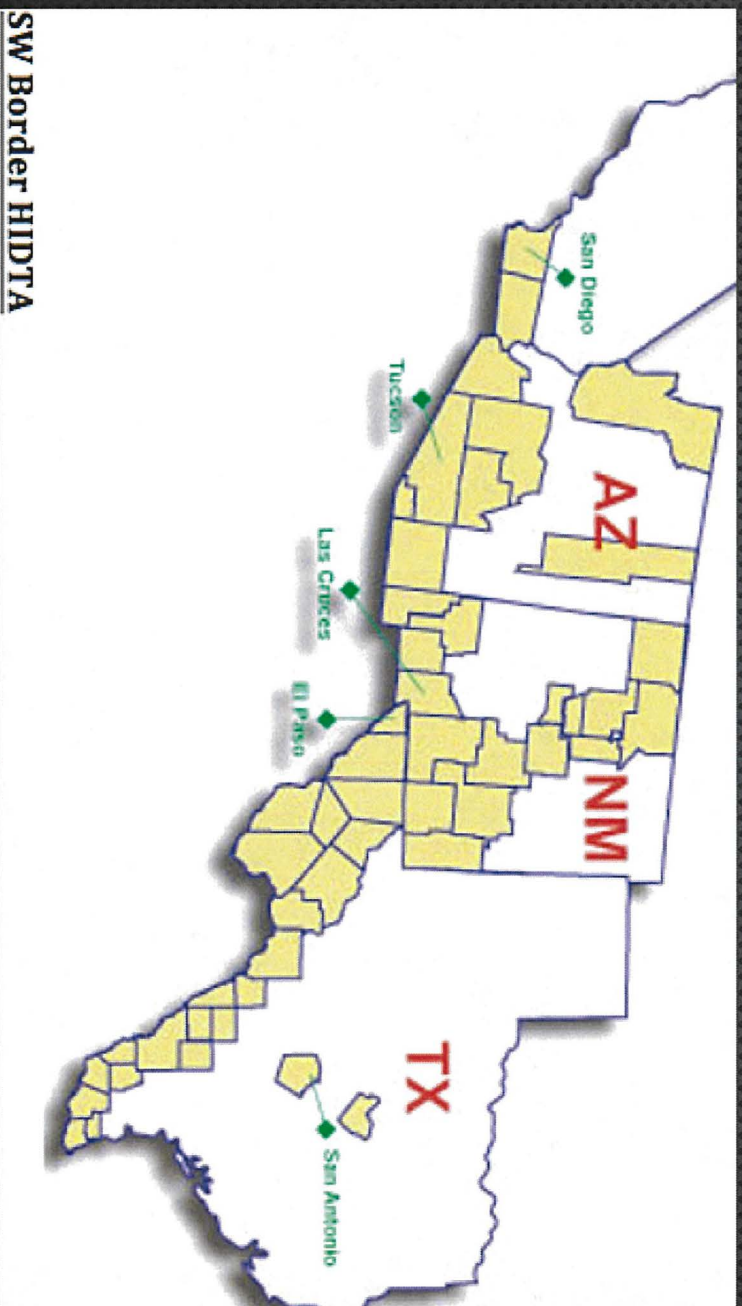

WHAT IS HIDTA?

- CONGRESS CREATED OFFICE OF NATIONAL DRUG CONTROL POLICY IN THE ANTI-DRUG ABUSE ACT OF 1988
- NEW MEXICO INCLUDED AS ONE OF FIRST FIVE HIDTAS IN 1990 (LOS ANGELES, HOUSTON, NEW YORK, MIAMI, SOUTHWEST BORDER)
- COMPRISED OF FEDERAL, STATE, LOCAL, AND TRIBAL RESOURCES

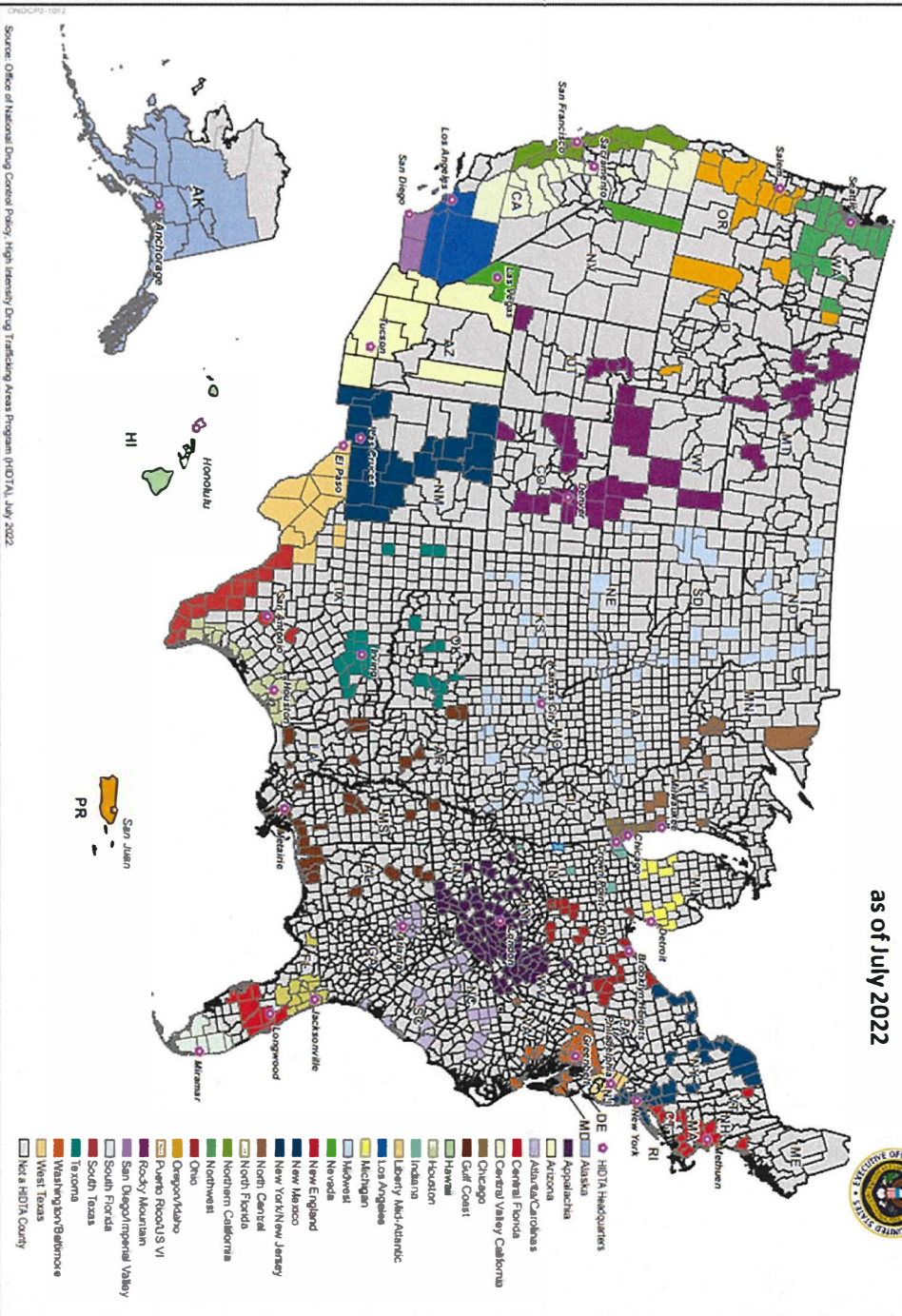

OUR MISSION

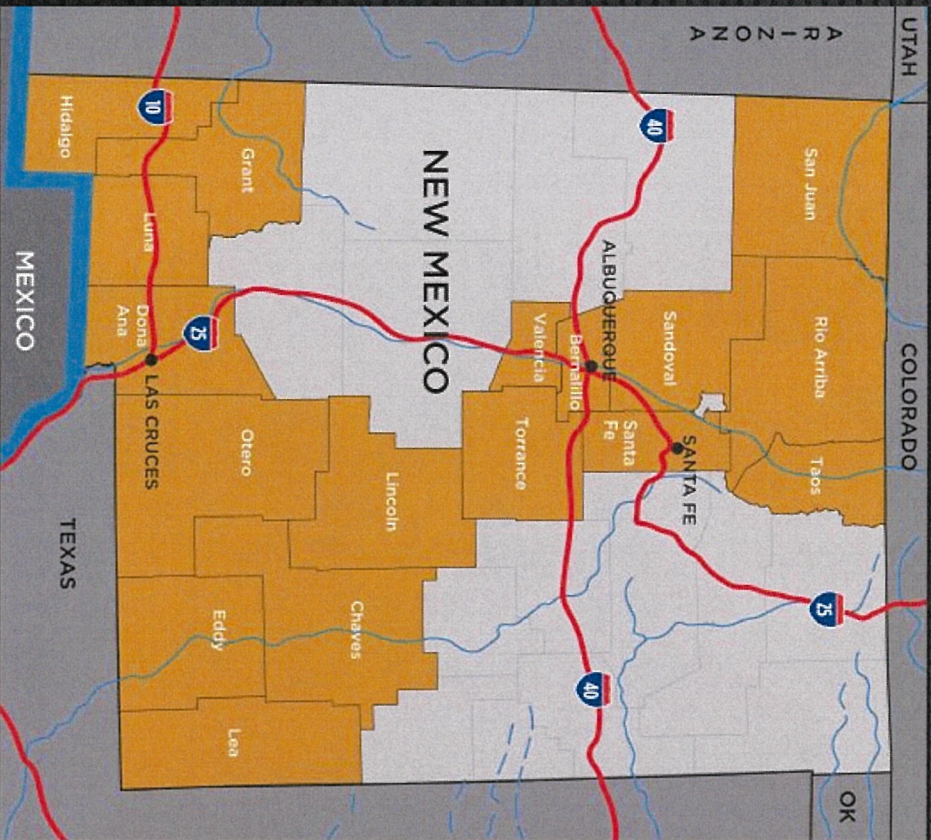

as of July 2022

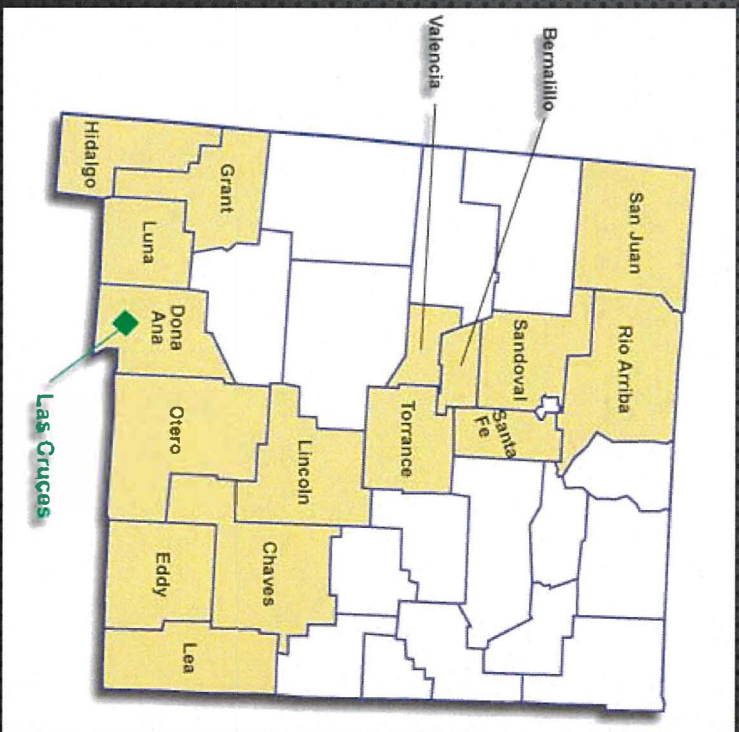
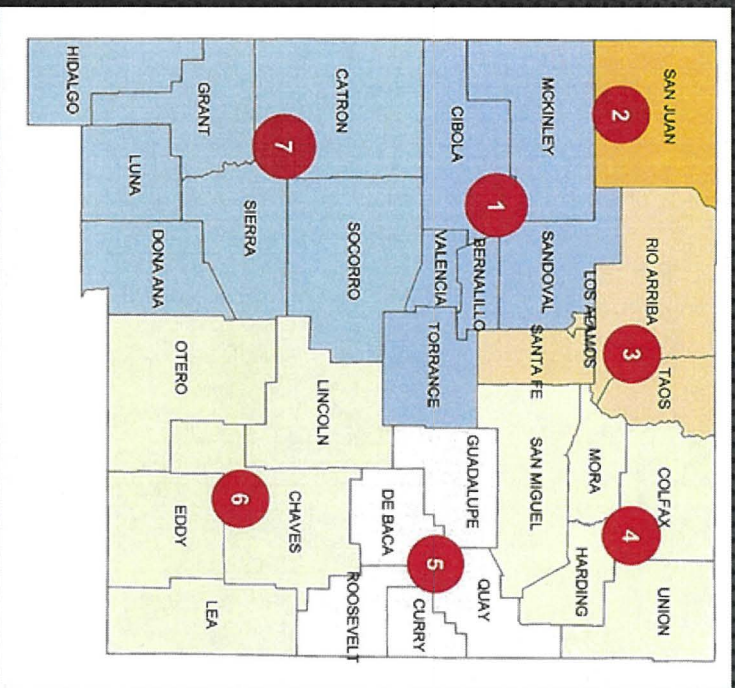


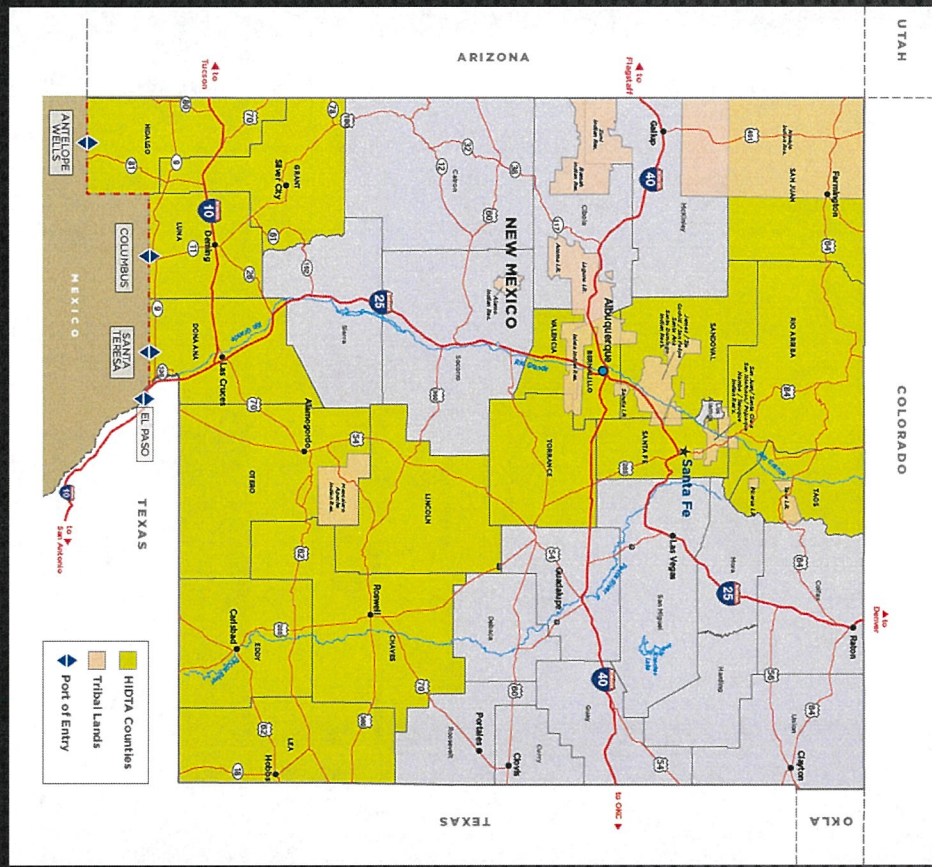

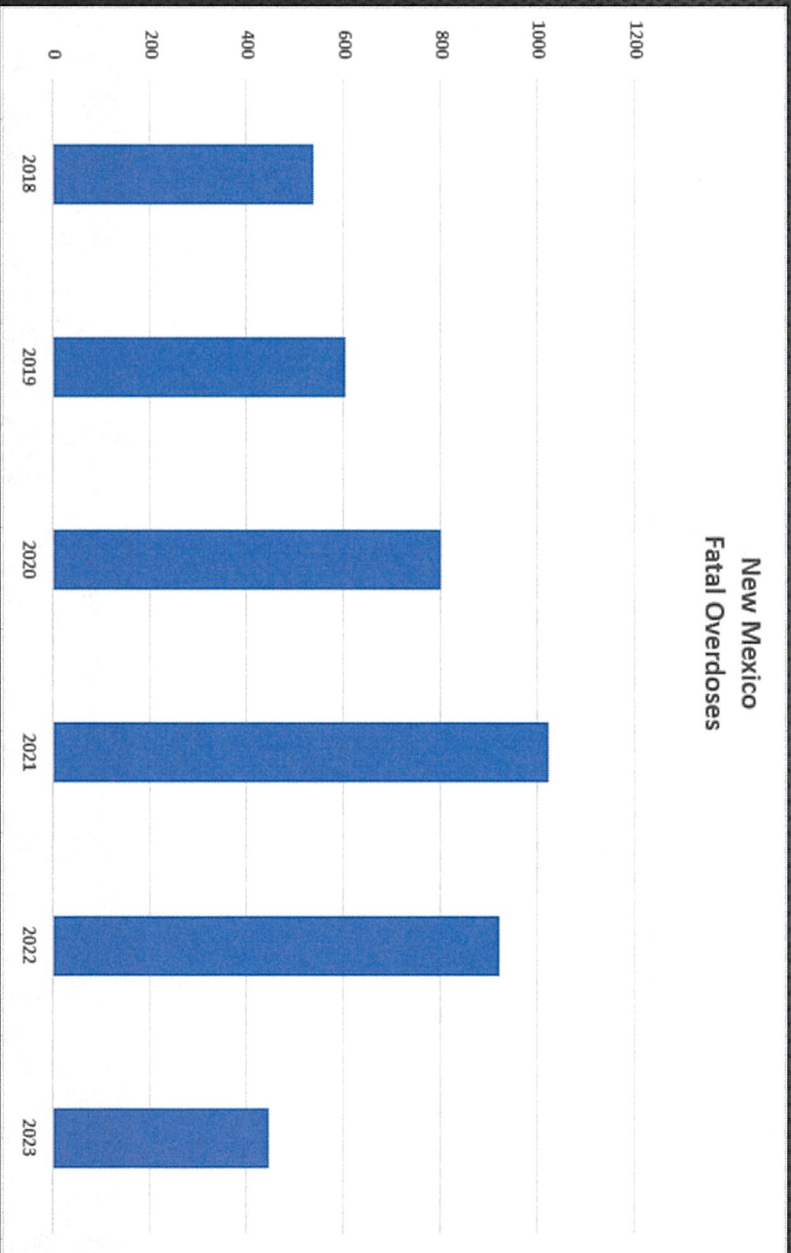
- A HIDTA Intelligence Initiative

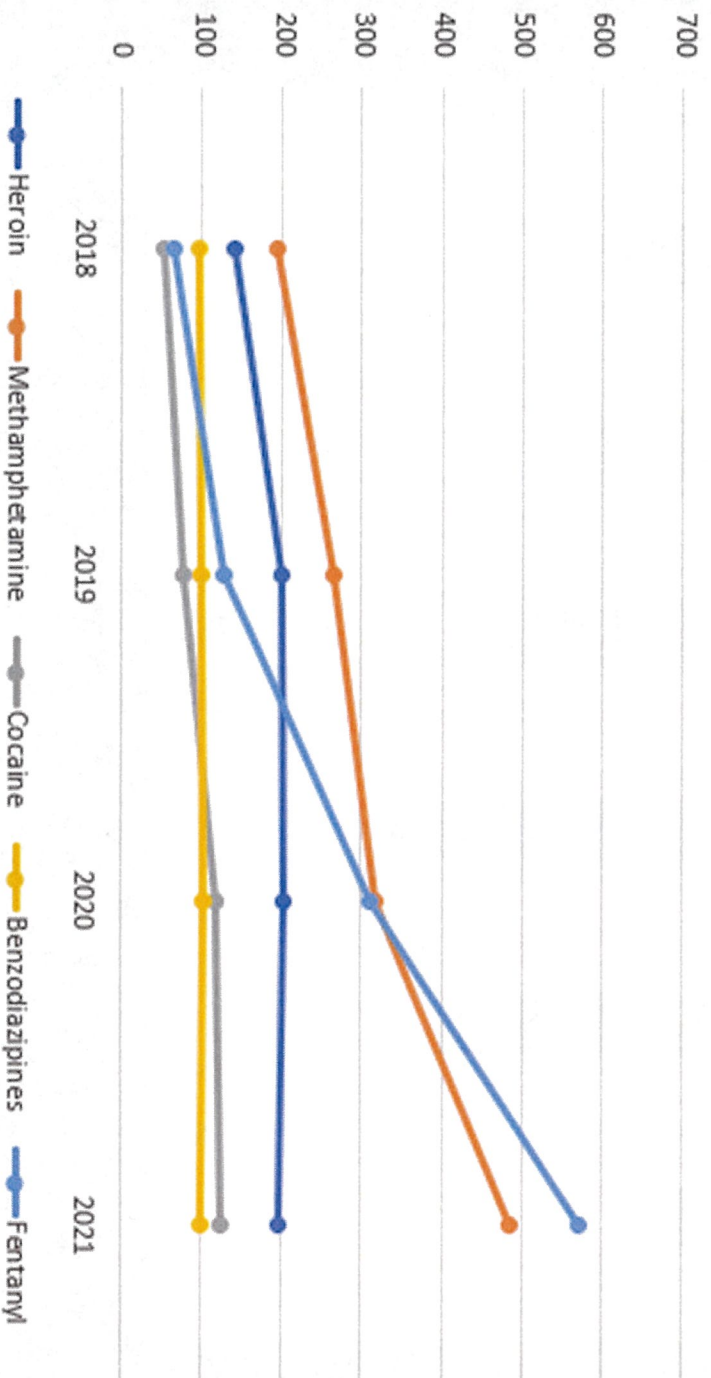

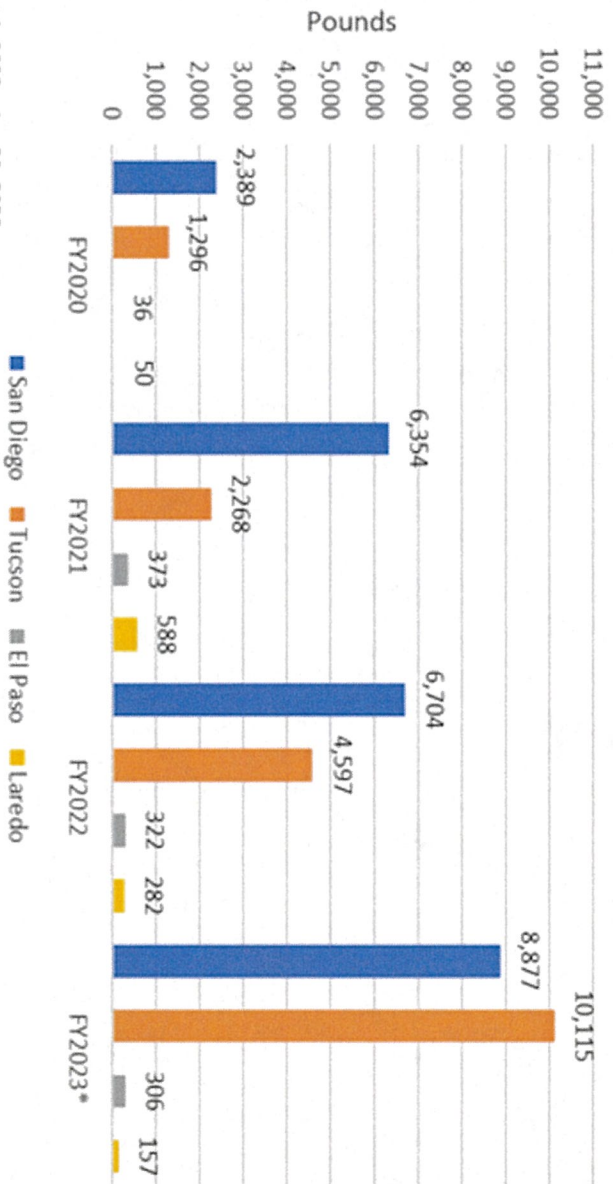
Fatal Drug Overdose by Drug Class 2018-2021

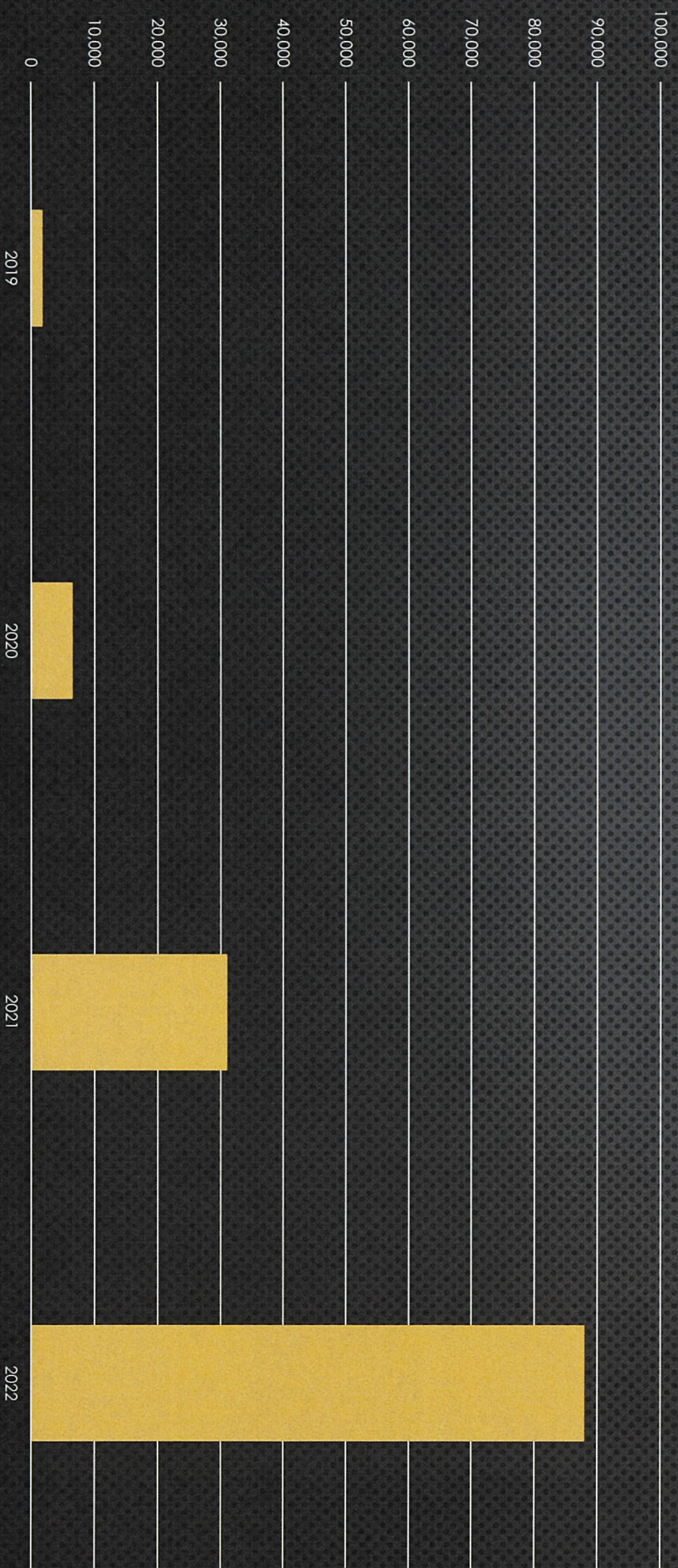
