Quarterly Report, November 2022



Outstanding Capital Funds Total \$3.5 Billion

At the end of the first quarter of FY23, outstanding capital outlay funds totaled an estimated \$3.5 billion, including projects authorized by the Legislature through 2022 (\$1.9 billion), earmark projects (\$283.2 million), supplemental severance tax bonds for public schools (\$517.3 million), and special appropriations to capital projects (\$779.7 million). The last figure represents uncommitted and unspent funds from \$977.4 million in special appropriations during the 2021 special and 2022 regular sessions as of October 2022.

Key Points

- Among three major categories of capital outlay, local projects have the
 most outstanding funds and slowest expenditure rates, with \$935.3 million
 outstanding or 71 percent of 2019 to 2022 appropriations (See Table 1).
 Statewide and higher education projects have spent funds more quickly,
 with 64 percent and 65 percent of appropriations outstanding, respectively.
- An estimated \$15.7 million in unspent funds reverted at the end of FY22.
- The Board of Finance split the severance tax bond sale for new projects into two issuances due to market conditions. Roughly \$322.5 million was sold in June and \$317 million in September. Sold and unsold severance tax bond projects authorized by the 2022 Legislature for \$1 million or more are now tracked in **Attachment A**. All authorized but unissued projects are listed in **Attachment E**.
- Projects approved by voters through the passage of general obligation bond questions in November 2022 will tentatively have bonds sold in March. The general obligation bonds (GOB) fund libraries, senior centers, and higher education institutions. LFC expects to begin tracking the new GOB projects next spring.
- Roughly 4,200 active projects are underway.
- Severance tax bonds are the primary source of outstanding balances, accounting for 69 percent of unexpended funds (\$1.5 billion). Other major sources include general fund (\$320.2 million) and general obligation bonds (\$220.4 million).

LFC QUARTERLY REPORTS provide analysis on the progress of capital appropriations.

Data is derived from the Department of Finance and Administration, state and local entities, and the Capital Project Monitoring System. Outstanding balances reflect expenditures as of late September 2022 and do not include encumbered but unspent funds.

\$1 Million and Greater Report (Attachment A)

As of September 2022, LFC staff tracked 534 active capital appropriations and 20 recently closed appropriations of \$1 million or more. A total of \$2.3 billion was appropriated to these projects, with unexpended balances of approximately \$1.7 billion.

Blue Projects, Table 2, Page 4. Blue-rated projects indicate that an appropriation has been reported as completely expended or reverted.

- In the last quarter, 20 appropriations totaling \$54.2 million were expended or reverted.
- Key appropriations in this category include \$9 million to the State Engineer for Indian Water Rights settlement; \$9 million to the Public Education Department for school bus replacement statewide; \$6 million for public school security systems statewide; and \$2 million for improvements to the Curry County courthouse.

Red Projects, Table 3, Page 5. Red-rated projects indicate no progress, no reporting, bonds not issued due to non-readiness, or significant obstacles to completion. Challenges for red-rated projects may include lack of planning, inadequate funds to fulfill a functional phase, and limited technical, financial, or administrative resources at the local level to move projects forward. Examples of significant delays this quarter include ongoing delays with right-of-way acquisitions, land sale delays, bonds not sold, and bidding issues.

- In the last quarter, 81 projects totaling \$236.4 million with \$202.5 million in unexpended balances were rated red.
- Projects in this category include \$14.5 million for construction of a gas pipeline from Dixon to Penasco; two reauthorized appropriations to the Spaceport Authority totaling \$25.6 million; \$7.9 million in general obligation bonds to Eastern New Mexico University for pending construction of the Roosevelt Science Hall with a June 2023 reversion date; and \$6.4 million in general obligation bonds to New Mexico Highlands University for renovations to Sininger Hall, for which the university is seeking additional funds to hire a general contractor and begin construction.

Yellow Projects, Table 4, Page 8. Yellow-rated projects indicate that a project is behind schedule, according to reporting available in CPMS, is facing some challenges but still progressing, or has not had significant expenditures. Challenges for yellow-rated projects may include limited resources at the local level, materials and mobilization costs, supply chain delays, and more.

- In the last quarter, 107 projects totaling \$347.4 million with \$258.2 million in unexpended balances were rated yellow.
- Projects in this category include \$33 million in general obligation bonds to the Aging and Long-Term Services Department for 2020 senior center projects, which includes a reported 12-month delay in receiving ordered vehicles; \$20 million to the Spaceport Authority for the construction of a payload center and IT building; \$16.8 million for Albuquerque-Bernalillo County regional emergency communications infrastructure; \$12.8 million

to Central New Mexico Community College for the construction of a new student services facility; and \$11.3 million to University of New Mexico for a group of nine academic and research infrastructure improvements with a project requesting additional funds and one on hold.

Earmark Projects (Attachments B, C, D)

Balances for projects funded through severance tax bond earmarks are provided in Attachments B (Water Trust Board), C (Colonias Infrastructure Fund), and D (Tribal Infrastructure Fund).

Authorized But Unissued Projects (Attachment E)

Attachment E provides a list of projects authorized by the Legislature for which severance tax bonds have not yet been sold. The Board of Finance split the bond sale for new 2022 projects into two issuances due to market conditions. Roughly \$322.5 million was sold in June and approximately \$317 million was sold in September.
