5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the answer brief shall be timely if filed **on**
6 **or before Sunday, November 12, 2023;**

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the reply brief, if any, shall be timely if
8 filed **on or before Friday, November 17, 2023;**

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the briefs shall comply with the
10 requirements in Rule 12-318 NMRA;

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that no extensions of time for the filing of
12 briefs set forth in this order will be granted;

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Rule 12-308 NMRA shall not apply to the
14 computation of time for purposes of the deadlines set forth in this order due to the
15 expedited nature of the briefing schedule;

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that oral argument shall be heard on **Tuesday,**
17 **November 21, 2023, at 9:30 a.m.**
