20	A. The total program units for the purpose of

Act, Section 22-8-23.4 NMSA 1978, is enacted to read:

"22-8-23.4. [NEW MATERIAL] NATIONAL BOARD FOR PROFESSIONAL TEACHING STANDARDS--CERTIFIED TEACHERS PROGRAM UNITS.--The number of program units received by a district for teachers certified by the national board for professional teaching standards is determined by multiplying by 1.5 the number of certified school instructors who are verified by the department as nationally board certified and employed by the school district on or before the fortieth day of the school year. Department approval of the program units shall be contingent on verification by the school district that the teachers who are certified by the national board for professional teaching standards are receiving as compensation for their national board certification a one-time increase in salary equal to or greater than the amount generated by the program units multiplied by the program unit value during the fiscal year in which the school district will receive the units."

Section 3. APPROPRIATION.--Three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the state department of public education for expenditure in fiscal year 2001 to provide teachers as compensation for their national board for professional teaching standards certification with a one-time increase in salary. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2001 shall revert to the general fund.
