AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL PROJECTS; PROVIDING LEGISLATIVE
AUTHORIZATION FOR THE NEW MEXICO FINANCE AUTHORITY TO MAKE
LOANS FOR PUBLIC PROJECTS FROM THE PUBLIC PROJECT REVOLVING
FUND; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. AUTHORIZATION OF PROJECTS.--Pursuant to the
provisions of Section 6-21-6 NMSA 1978, the legislature
authorizes the New Mexico finance authority to make loans
from the public project revolving fund to the following

4 Section 2. VOIDING OF AUTHORIZATION.--If a qualified
5 entity listed in Section 1 of this act has not certified to
6 the New Mexico finance authority by the end of fiscal year
7 2003 its desire to continue to pursue a loan from the public
8 project revolving fund for a public project listed in that
9 section, the legislative authorization granted to the New
10 Mexico finance authority by that section to make a loan from
11 the public project revolving fund to that qualified entity
12 for that public project is void.

13 Section 3. CERTIFICATES OF PARTICIPATION--AUTHORIZATION
14 TO PURCHASE LOANS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section
15 6-21-6 NMSA 1978, the legislature authorizes the New Mexico
16 finance authority to use funds on deposit in the public
