AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO FUND A TRAINING AND EMPLOYMENT
PROGRAM IN LOS ALAMOS FOR NEW MEXICO WORKS ACT PROGRAM
PARTICIPANTS THAT MEETS THE TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE FOR NEEDY
FAMILIES MAINTENANCE OF EFFORT REQUIREMENT; DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Two hundred thousand dollars
(\$200,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the labor
department for expenditure in fiscal years 2000 and 2001 for
the purpose of contracting with Los Alamos national
laboratory to implement a training and employment program for
participants of the New Mexico Works Act program. The
program shall provide a tracking and reporting element. The
appropriation shall not be expended for any purpose that may
jeopardize its classification as maintenance of effort. The

1 human services department shall ensure that expenditures meet
2 all federal and state requirements for maintenance of effort.
3 The appropriation shall be reported by the human services
4 department as maintenance of effort. Any unexpended or
5 unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2001
6 shall revert to the general fund.

7 Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public
8 peace, health and safety that this act take effect
9 immediately.
