Section 1. APPROPRIATIONTwo hundred thousand dollars
(\$200,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the labor
department for expenditure in fiscal years 2000 and 2001 for
the purpose of contracting with Los Alamos national
aboratory to implement a training and employment program for
participants of the New Mexico Works Act program. The
rogram shall provide a tracking and reporting element. The
appropriation shall not be expended for any purpose that may
jeopardize its classification as maintenance of effort. The
