11 RELATING TO NATURAL RESOURCES CONSERVATION; MAKING AN
12 APPROPRIATION FOR THE ACQUISITION OF EAGLE NEST LAKE AND
13 ENVIRONS.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

16 Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Two million dollars
17 (\$2,000,000) is appropriated from the game protection fund
18 and two million dollars (\$2,000,000) is appropriated from the
19 general fund to the property control division of the general
20 services department for expenditure in fiscal years 2001
21 through 2009 to begin acquiring Eagle Nest and environs. The
22 property control division may propose land for trade as part
23 of the purchase agreement. The property control division
24 shall report to the legislature by December 1, 2000 on the
25 progress toward finalization of the purchase. Any unexpended
or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year
2009 shall revert to the game protection fund.
