Section 1. APPROPRIATIONMATCH REQUIREDFive hundred
thousand dollars (\$500,000) is appropriated from the general
fund to the board of regents of New Mexico state university
for expenditure in fiscal years 2001 and 2002 for the New
Mexico department of agriculture to provide matching funds
for water quality and water conservation projects, including
watershed enhancement, in soil and water conservation
districts statewide. The soil and water conservation
commission shall approve applications for funding. At least
