SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

This bill appropriates \$600.0 from the general fund to the Board of Regents of the New Mexico State University for the purpose of increasing women's sports activities to comply with Title 9 of the federal Education Amendments of 1972.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$600.0 contained in this bill is a recurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of FY01 shall revert to the general fund.

RELATIONSHIP

This bill relates to House Bill 2 and Senate Bill 2 which contain \$2,616.2 in athletic funding for NMSU.

OTHER SUBSTANTIVE ISSUES

The CHE recommends that the following language be included for all new recurring higher education programs: "The institution receiving the special appropriation in this bill shall submit a program evaluation to the LFC and the CHE by August 1, 2003 detailing the benefits to the State from having this program implemented for a three-year period."
