SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 224 appropriates \$190.0 from the general fund to the Local Government Division of DFA for operational expenses for the Chaves County Unity Center.

Significant Issues

The bill proposes to provide funding to a youth development program that provides constructive alternatives for youth.

The Unity Center is a private/non-profit youth organization.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

TECHNICAL ISSUES
