## **SUMMARY**

### Synopsis of Bill

This joint memorial requests the department to reconstruct Gurley Drive in Gallup to ease congestion at the University of New Mexico Gallup Branch.

### Significant Issues

The project calls for improvements to the only access and exit road to the UNM Gallup campus. Improvements consist of repaving Gurley Drive, curb and gutter, access improvements, sidewalks, various pavement markings, traffic signs, grade adjustment of several existing utilities and other various improvements associated with this project. Total cost of the project is \$705.0.
