WHEREAS, the education initiatives and accountability task force desires that by New Mexico's one hundredth birthday, in 2012, all students will graduate from high school multilingual and prepared for higher education and productive careers and hopes that the implementation of innovative educational initiatives will help us reach this goal; and

WHEREAS, in order for all students to graduate from high school multilingual and prepared for higher education and productive careers, it is imperative for a review to be conducted of the current rules and statutes in order to assess which rules and statutes hamper innovations and impede initiatives that may improve our state's educational system;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that, to improve lifelong learning and to provide the children of this state with a quality education so that they may be prepared for higher education and productive careers and to be productive citizens of this state, the legislative education study committee, the New Mexico legislative council, the state department of public education and the commission on higher education be requested to conduct a sweeping review of the rules and statutes
