WHEREAS, he was a founding member of the Stephenson and Olmsted law firm in 1962; and

WHEREAS, he served our country in the United States navy .132131.1

during World War II, was awarded the Bronze Star and retired as a lieutenant commander in the naval reserve; and

WHEREAS, he graduated from the university of Kansas and the university of Kansas law school; and

WHEREAS, he gave to many charities, including the Donnan Stephenson lecture series at his alma mater; and

WHEREAS, he is preceded in death by his wife, Patricia Stephenson; and

WHEREAS, he is survived by his sons, Mark and Bruce Stephenson and three grandchildren, Autumn, Quinn and Erin Li Stephenson;
