AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES; INCREASING THE PENALTY ASSESSMENT FOR SPEEDING IN A CONSTRUCTION ZONE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 66-8-116 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1978, Chapter 35, Section 524, as amended) is amended to read:

"66-8-116. PENALTY ASSESSMENT MISDEMEANORS--

DEFINITION--SCHEDULE OF ASSESSMENTS.--

A. As used in the Motor Vehicle Code, "penalty assessment misdemeanor" means violation of any of the following listed sections of the NMSA 1978 for which, except as provided in Subsection D of this section, the listed penalty assessment is established:

8 B. The term "penalty assessment misdemeanor" does
9 not include any violation that has caused or contributed to
10 the cause of an accident resulting in injury or death to any
11 person.

12 C. When an alleged violator of a penalty assessment
13 misdemeanor elects to accept a notice to appear in lieu of a
14 notice of penalty assessment, no fine imposed upon later
15 conviction shall exceed the penalty assessment established for
16 the particular penalty assessment misdemeanor and no probation
17 imposed upon a suspended or deferred sentence shall exceed
18 ninety days.

19 D. The penalty assessment for speeding in violation
20 of Paragraph (4) of Subsection A of Section 66-7-301 NMSA 1978
21 is twice the penalty assessment established in Subsection A of
22 this section for the equivalent miles per hour over the speed
23 limit. "
