**AN ACT**

**RELATING TO THE JUVENILE PAROLE BOARD; PROVIDING PER DIEM FOR  
OFFICIAL DUTIES OF THE BOARD; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:**

**Section 1. Section 32A-7-1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1993,  
Chapter 77, Section 194) is amended to read:**

**"32A-7-1. SHORT TITLE. --Chapter [32] 32A, Article 7 NMSA  
1978 may be cited as the "Juvenile Parole Board Act". "**

**Section 2. Section 32A-7-7 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1993,  
Chapter 77, Section 200) is amended to read:**

**"32A-7-7. COMPENSATION. --The members of the juvenile  
parole board shall receive per diem and mileage as provided  
for nonsalaried public officers in the Per Diem and Mileage  
Act [~~and shall receive no other compensation, perquisite or  
allowance~~] for all official duties performed for the juvenile**

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1 parole board, including one day of per diem for the review of  
2 case files. "

3 Section 3. APPROPRIATION. --Twenty-three thousand four  
4 hundred dollars (\$23,400) is appropriated from the general  
5 fund to the juvenile parole board for expenditure in fiscal  
6 year 2002 to provide additional per diem to juvenile parole  
7 board members for performing their official duties as set  
8 forth in Section 32A-7-7 NMSA 1978. Any unexpended or  
9 unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2002  
10 shall revert to the general fund.

11 Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. --The effective date of the  
12 provisions of this act is July 1, 2001.
