**AN ACT**

**MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR BEHAVIORAL HEALTH PROGRAMS NOT PROVIDED BY MEDICAID.**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:**

**Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --**

**A. One million two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$1,250,000) is appropriated from the general fund for expenditure in fiscal year 2002 in the following amounts for the following purposes:**

**(1) seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) to the children, youth and families department to contract for services and programs not provided under medicaid, including intensive outpatient programs, school-based services, outpatient clinics, wrap-around services, mobile crisis teams, early childhood family-based prevention,**

1 crisis stabilization, transitional living, transportation and  
2 prevention services; and

3 (2) five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000)  
4 to the department of health to contract for services and  
5 programs not covered by medicaid, including intensive  
6 outpatient programs, outpatient clinics, wrap-around services,  
7 mobile crisis teams, crisis stabilization, transitional  
8 living, transportation, prevention services and consumer-  
9 driven services.

10 B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance  
11 remaining at the end of fiscal year 2002 shall revert to the  
12 general fund.
