**AN ACT**

**MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A NEW MEXICO MENTAL HEALTH SYSTEM  
INITIATIVE.**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:**

**Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --**

**A. Nine million ninety-eight thousand five hundred  
dollars (\$9,098,500) is appropriated from the general fund to  
the department of health for expenditure in fiscal year 2002  
to develop and implement a statewide mental health system for  
the following purposes in the following amounts:**

**(1) two million fifty-one thousand five  
hundred dollars (\$2,051,500) for twenty-two new intensive and  
intermediate care inpatient beds at the Las Vegas medical  
center;**

**(2) two million twenty-two thousand dollars**

- 1 (\$2,022,000) for a pharmacotherapy program;
- 2 (3) two million dollars (\$2,000,000) for a
- 3 psychiatric crisis response program;
- 4 (4) one million five hundred thousand dollars
- 5 (\$1,500,000) for intensive mental health services;
- 6 (5) one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for dual
- 7 diagnosis services; and
- 8 (6) five hundred twenty-five thousand dollars
- 9 (\$525,000) for jail diversion programs.

10 B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance  
11 remaining at the end of fiscal year 2002 shall revert to the  
12 general fund.
