**AN ACT**

**MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR CONSERVATION OF NEW MEXICO PUBLIC  
ART CREATED DURING THE DEPRESSION ERA AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLIC  
EDUCATION ABOUT THIS UNIQUE NATIONAL ART TREASURE.**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:**

**Section 1. APPROPRIATION. - -**

**A. Seven hundred twenty-five thousand one hundred  
dollars (\$725,100) is appropriated from the general fund to  
the office of cultural affairs for expenditure in fiscal years  
2002 and 2003 in the following amounts for the following  
purposes:**

**(1) six hundred five thousand one hundred  
dollars (\$605,100) to restore and conserve depression-era  
public works of art statewide;**

1 (2) twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) to  
2 plan, produce and distribute a video documentary, in  
3 cooperation with the university of New Mexico public  
4 television station, about the depression-era public art in New  
5 Mexico; and

6 (3) one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000)  
7 to contract for services and expenses to administer the  
8 projects established under Paragraphs (1) and (2) of this  
9 subsection.

10 B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance  
11 remaining at the end of fiscal year 2003 shall revert to the  
12 general fund.
