Synopsis of Bill

Senate Memorial 8 asks the board of county commissioners of Valencia county 1) to conduct a study of inappropriate dumping and accumulation of trash in Valencia county; 2) to begin to solve the trash problem; and 3) to report its findings to the senate by January 15, 2002.

Significant Issues

The memorial notes that the board of county commissioners is the entity best suited to addressing the problems of inappropriate dumping and trash in Valencia county.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

This is a memorial with no appropriation.

There is no fiscal impact to the state.

Depending on the board's response to the memorial, there could be some fiscal implications for Valencia county if staff time and county resources are tasked for the study.
