REQUESTI NG THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLI C EDUCATI ON TO DEVELOP AND STRENGTHEN ASSESSMENTS AND CURRI CULA FOR NATI VE AMERI CAN BI LI NGUAL PROGRAMS AND TO STRENGTHEN LI CENSURE REQUI REMENTS FOR NATI VE AMERI CAN BI LI NGUAL TEACHERS.

WHEREAS, t he legi s at ure desires t hat students in the state achi eve multilingual profici ency by becoming proficient in Engl ish and one ot her I anguage; and

WHEREAS, the legi sl at ure desires that, al ong with ot her I anguages, New Mexi co students have the opportunity to become prof ici ent in Native Arrerican I anguages; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide students with the opportunity to become proficient in Native American I anguages, assessments and curricula for Native American bilingual prograns need to be provided, as well as additional teachers certified to teach Native Ameri can I anguages; and

WHEREAS, state department of public education rul es do not currently provide for assessments and curricula for Native American bilingual prograns; and

WHEREAS, because of a lack of trai ni ng prograns in New Mexi co and excessi ve costs associ ated with training out of state, state department of public education licensure requi rements for teachers of bilingual programs do not encourage teachers to become certified in Native Arerican
bilingual prograns;
NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGI SLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXI CO that the state department of publ ic education be requested to devel op and strengthen assessments and curricula for Native American bilingual prograns within its rules; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the state department of publ ic education be requested to strengthen its Native American licensure requi rements and to encourage nore teachers to become licensed to teach Native American I anguages through trai ni ng programs in New Mexico or by assi sting teachers in becoming certified out of state; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the superintendent of public instruction.
