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1 health care task force;

2 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE
3 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the legislative health subcommittee
4 designate a blue ribbon health care task force to:

5 A. assist the legislative health subcommittee with
6 its systematic assessment of the existing financing, delivery,
7 organization and performance of health care in New Mexico;

8 B. conduct studies, interviews and town hall
9 meetings to obtain information on the needs, challenges and
10 expectations of health care consumers and professionals and
11 present its findings to the legislative health subcommittee;
12 and

13 C. review the existing state health-care-related
14 information systems to determine the progress of state
15 agencies' efforts and plans to meet the administrative
16 simplification requirements; and

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the blue ribbon health care
18 task force be comprised of one representative from each of the
19 following groups: managed care organizations; non-managed care
20 health insurers; the office of the attorney general; consumers;
21 health care provider associations; non-physician health care
22 providers; and experts in health care organization and finance
23 not employed with or contracted by managed care organizations,
24 health care insurers or health care providers; and

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the blue ribbon health care

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1 task force present its findings and recommendations to the
2 legislative health subcommittee by November 1, 2001 for
3 consideration by the second session of the forty-fifth
4 legislature; and

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be
6 transmitted to the New Mexico legislative council and
7 appropriate executive agencies.

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
