**WHEREAS, when he lived in Albuquerque, he met his sweetheart and future wife, Sally Chacon, and married her on**

3 their marriage in Nevada and later moved back to Albuquerque,  
4 where they raised their sons, Louie and Danny, and daughter  
5 Teresa; and

6 WHEREAS, Joe worked at Sandia national laboratories for  
7 twenty years until his retirement, whereupon he began to work  
8 for the New Mexico legislature in 1988 and continued working  
9 for each legislative session until his death in November 2000;

11 WHEREAS, although Joe was a very quiet and modest person,  
12 he was very caring and had a unique sense of humor and a  
13 little wry smile that always kept people guessing, trying to  
14 figure him out; and

15 WHEREAS, Joe was positive about every situation that came  
16 his way and never had a bad word to say about anyone he met,  
17 including Republicans!;

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE  
19 OF NEW MEXICO that condolences be extended to Joe Holcomb's  
20 wife Sally, their children Louie, Danny and Teresa and their  
21 granddaughters Lea, Sonia and Megan over the loss of their
