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## A J OINT RESOLUTI ON

PROPOSI NG AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTI TUTI ON OF NEW MEXI CO TO ABOLI SH THE ELECTED POSI TI ON OF COUNTY CLERK.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEG SLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXI CO:
Section 1. It is proposed to amend Article 6, Section 22 of the constitution of New Mexi co to read:
"Until otherwi se provi ded by Iaw, a county clerk [shal+ be elected in each county whe] shall [in the county for wich he is elected] performall the duties now performed by the [elerks of the district courts and] clerks of the probate courts."

Section 2. It is proposed to amend Article 10, Section 2 of the constitution of New Mexi co to read:
"A. In every county all el ected officials shal I serve four-year terms, subject to the provisions of Subsection . 134884. 1
$B$ of this section.
B. In those counties that prior to 1992 have not had four-year terns for el ected officials, the assessor, sheriff and probate judge shall be el ected to four-year terns and the treasurer [and clerk] shall be el ected to a two-year [terms termin the first el ection following the adoption of this amendment. In subsequent el ections, the treasurer [and flerk] shall be el ected to a four-year [terms] term
C. To provi de for stagger ed county commission terms, in counties with three county commissioners, the terms of no more than two commissioners shall expire in the same year; and in counties with five county commi ssi oners, the terns of no more than three commissioners shall expire in the same year.
D. All county officers, after having served two consecutive four-year terms, shall be ineligi ble to hol d any county office for two years ther eafter.
E. Upon adoption of this amendment by the people, the position of county clerk shall not be on the ball ot begi nning with the general el ection in 2002. El ected county clerks may fill out the remainder of their terns."

Section 3. The amendment proposed by this resol ution shall be submitted to the people for thei $r$ approval or rejection at the next general el ection or at any special el ection prior to that date whi ch may be called for that purpose.
