A J OI NT RESOLUTI ON
PROPOSI NG AN AMENDMENT TO ARTI CLE 7, SECTI ON 1 OF THE CONSTI TUTI ON OF NEW MEXI CO TO REMDVE THE RESTRI CTI ON ON WHEN SCHOOL ELECTI ONS MAY BE HELD, PROVI DE THAT REGULAR SCHOOL DI STRI CT ELECTI ONS W LL BE HELD W TH THE GENERAL ELECTI ON AND UPDATE THE CONSTI TUTI ON TO REFLECT THE VOTI NG AGE PURSUANT TO FEDERAL LAW

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEG SLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXI CO:
Section 1. It is proposed to amend Article 7, Section 1 of the constitution of New Mexi co to read:
"Every citizen of the United States, who is over the age of [twenty-one] ei ghteen years, and has resi ded in New Mexi co twel ve mont hs, in the county ni nety days, and in the precinct in whi ch he offers to vote thirty days, next preceding the el ection, except idi ots, insane persons and persons convicted
of a fel oni ous or infamous crime unl ess restored to political rights, shall be qualified to vote at all el ections for public officers. The I egislat ure my enact I aws providing for absentee voting by qualified el ectors. [All school elections shall be held at different times from other elections.] Regul ar school di strict el ections shall be held with the gener al el ection.

The I egi slature shall have the power to require the registration of the qualified el ectors as a requisite for voting, and shall regul ate the manner, time and places of voting. The I egi slature shall enact such laws as will secure the secrecy of the ballot, the purity of el ections and guard agai nst the abuse of el ective franchise. Not more than two members of the board of registration, and not more than two judges of el ection shall bel ong to the same political party at the time of their appoi nt ment."

Section 2. The amendment proposed by this resol ution shall be submitted to the people for thei $r$ approval or rejection at the next general el ection or at any special el ection prior to that date whi ch may be called for that pur pose.
