AN ACT
RELATI NG TO THE REDI STRI CTI NG OF THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATI ON; ESTABLI SHI NG STATE BOARD OF EDUCATI ON DI STRI CTS; PROVI DI NG THE METHOD FOR ELECTI NG MEMBERS; PROVI DI NG FOR THE FI LLI NG OF VACANCI ES; FI XI NG THE NUMBER, RESI DENCE AND TERMS OF MEMBERS; REPEALI NG AND ENACTI NG SECTI ONS OF THE NMSA 1978.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEG SLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXI CO:
Section 1. SHORT TITLE.--Thi s act may be cited as the " 2001 Educational Redistricting Act".

Section 2. PRECI NCTS. --
A. Precinct desi gnations and boundaries used in the 2001 Educational Redistricting Act are those precinct desi gnations and boundaries established pursuant to the Preci nct Boundary Adj ustment Act and revi sed and approved pursuant to that act by the secretary of state as of August . 138948. 1

31, 2001.
B. A board of county commi ssi oners shall not create any preci nct that lies in more than one state board of education di strict, and shall not di vi de any preci nct so that the di vi ded parts of the precinct are situated in two or more state board of education districts. Votes cast in a statewide el ection frompreci ncts created or di vided in viol ation of this subsection are invalid and shall not be counted or canvassed.

Section 3. STATE BOARD OF EDUCATI ON- MEMBERSHI P. - - The state board of education is composed of ten el ected members and five appoi nted members, one member el ected fromeach el ective board of education district and one menber appointed fromeach of five appointive di stricts.

Section 4. BOARD OF EDUCATI ON DI STRI CT ONE. - - Board of education district one is composed of Bernalillo county preci ncts 1 through 3, 20 through 30, 32 through 55, 61 through 67, 71 through 77, 80 through 85,87 through 92, 94, 96 through 99, 106, 111 through 114, 120 through 125, 131 through 133, 135, 154 and 162 through 166; and Sandoval county preci ncts 11 through 13, 53 and 54.

Section 5. BOARD OF EDUCATI ON DI STRI CT TVD. - - Board of education district two is composed of Bernalillo county preci ncts 289, 290, 293 through 308, 330 through 333, 400 through 409, 411 through 417, 419 through 421, 426 through . 138948. 1

430, 439, 440, 447, 449 through 454, 461 through 466, 471 through 474, 480 through 484, 487 through 500, 502 through 509, 511 through 541, 544 through 566, 568, 569, 571, 573 and 602.

Section 6. BOARD OF EDUCATI ON DI STRI CT THREE. - - Board of education di strict three is composed of Bernalillo county preci ncts 4 through 18, 86, 95, 101 through 105, 107, 150 through 153, 161, 180 through 187, 191 through 197, 211, 212, 214 through 217, 221, 223 through 226, 241 through 246, 251 through 258, 271 through 275, 278, 281 through 287, 291, 292, 311 through 318, 321 through 323, 326 through 329, 341 through 347, 351 through 358, 371 through 375, 381 through 387, 410, 418, 422 through 425, 431 through 438, 441 through 446, 475 through 478, 485, 486, 510, 542, 543 and 601.

Section 7. BOARD OF EDUCATI ON DI STRI CT FOUR. - - Board of education district four is composed of Bernalillo county preci nct 567; Sandoval county preci ncts 1 through 10, 14 through 20, 28 through 50, 55, 56, 58 through 64 and 67; and Santa Fe county precincts 8 through 14, 20 through 22, 24 through 39, 41 through 57, 62 through 72, 74 through 78, 80, 81, 83 and 86.

Section 8. BOARD OF EDUCATI ON DI STRI CT FI VE. - - Board of education district five is composed of MEKinley county; and San J uan count y.

Section 9. BOARD OF EDUCATI ON DI STRI CT SI X. -- Board of . 138948. 1
education di strict six is composed of Bernalillo county preci ncts 31 and 93; Catron county; Ci bol a county; Grant county; Hi dal go county; Luna county; Si erra county; Socorro county precincts 13 through 16; and Val encia county.

Section 10. BOARD OF EDUCATI ON DI STRI CT SEVEN. -- Board of education di strict seven is composed of Dona Ana county; and Ot ero county precinct 1 .

Section 11. BOARD OF EDUCATI ON DI STRI CT EI GHT. - - Board of education di strict ei ght is composed of Chaves county preci ncts 1 through 7, 9 through 16, 21 through 25, 31 through 36, 41 through 43, 51, 52, 61 through 63, 71 through 73, 81 through 85, 90 through 93 and 101 through 103; Li ncol n county; Ot ero county precincts 2 through 40; Santa Fe county precincts 15 through 19, 73, 84 and 85 ; Socorro county preci ncts 1 through 12 and 17; and Tor rance county.

Section 12. BOARD OF EDUCATI ON DI STRI CT NI NE. - - Board of education di strict ni ne is composed of Chaves county precinct 104; Cur ry county; De Baca county; Eddy county; Lea county; Quay county preci ncts 1 through 5; and Roosevel t county.

Section 13. BOARD OF EDUCATI ON DI STRI CT TEN. - - Board of education di strict ten is composed of Col fax county; Guadal upe county; Har di ng county; Los Al amos county; Mbra county; Quay county precincts 6 through 13; Rio Arri ba county; San M guel county; Sandoval county preci ncts 21 through 27 and 51; Santa Fe county preci ncts 1 through 7, 23, 40, 58 through 61, 79 and . 138948. 1

82; Taos county; and Uni on count y.
Section 14. APPOI NTI VE BOARD OF EDUCATI ON DI STRI CTS. -For the purposes of appointing members of the state board of education, five districts are created as follows:
A. appointive di strict $A$ consists of state board of education districts two and four;
B. appointive district $B$ consists of state board of education districts one and three;
C. appointive district $C$ consists of state board of education districts five and ten;
D. appointive di strict $D$ consists of state board of education di stricts six and seven; and
E. appointive di strict $E$ consists of state board of education districts ei ght and ni ne.

Section 15. RESI DENCE. - A candi date for the of fice of state board of education menber shall reside in the di strict for whi ch he files a decl aration of candi dacy at the time of such filing. If an el ected or appointed board member permanently removes his resi dence from or mai nt ai ns no residence in the district from whi ch he was el ected or appoi nted, he shall be deemed to have resigned and his successor shall be sel ected as provi ded in Sections 16 and 17 of the 2001 Educational Redistricting Act.

Section 16. ELECTED MEMBERS- - STAGGERED TERMS. - -
A. El ected menbers of the state board of education
shall be el ected for staggered terms of four years.
B. Board members shall be el ected at the general el ection for terns commencing on January 1 next succeeding thei $r$ el ection.
C. Board members from districts one, four, ei ght, ni ne and ten shal l be el ected at the general el ection in 2004 for terms that expire in 2008.
D. Board members from districts two, three, five, si $x$ and seven shall be el ected at the general el ection in 2002 for terms that expire in 2006.
E. The governor shall by appoi nt ment fill a vacancy in the office of an electen ment of the state board of education. An appoi ntee filling such a vacancy shall serve until a successor is el ected at the next general el ection. The successor shall be el ected to fill the unexpired termfor the district from whi ch the person creating the vacancy in the of fice was el ected.

Section 17. APPOI NTED MEMBERS- - STAGGERED TERMS. --
A. One nember of the state board of education shall be appoi nted fromeach of the five state board of education appointive di stricts by the governor by and with the consent of the senate.
B. Appoi nt ed members shall be appointed for staggered terms of four years.
C. Terns of appointed members shall expire on

December 31.
D. If a vacancy occurs in the office of an appoi nted member of the state board of education, it shall be filled by appoi nt ment of the governor by and with the consent of $t$ he senate for the remai nder of the term of the menber creating the vacancy.

Section 18. CONTI NUI NG TERMS. - - A menber of the state board of education who was appoi nted or el ected pursuant to the provisions of Laws 1991 (1st S. S.), Chapter 4, Sections 1 through 17 and who is serving on the board as of the effective date of thi s section shall serve the remai nder of the termfor whi ch he was el ected or appoi nted.

Section 19. REPEAL. - Sections 22-3-37through 22-3-54 NMSA 1978 ( bei ng Laws 1991 (1st S. S.), Chapter 4, Sections 1 through 18) are repeal ed.
