**AN ACT**

**RELATING TO THE REDISTRICTING OF THE CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS;  
ESTABLISHING CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS FOR THE ELECTION OF  
REPRESENTATIVES TO THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS; AMENDING,  
REPEALING AND ENACTING SECTIONS OF THE NMSA 1978.**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:**

**Section 1. Section 1-15-16 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1991  
(1st S.S.), Chapter 7, Section 1) is repealed and a new  
Section 1-15-16 NMSA 1978 is enacted to read:**

**"1-15-16. [NEW MATERIAL] UNITED STATES REPRESENTATIVE--  
COMPOSITION OF DISTRICTS. --**

**A. Congressional district one is composed of

A. Precinct designations and boundaries used in the ~~[1991]~~ 2001 congressional redistricting are those precinct designations and boundaries established pursuant to the Precinct Boundary Adjustment Act and revised and approved pursuant to that act by the secretary of state as of ~~[August 16, 1991]~~ August 31, 2001.

B. ~~[The boards]~~ A board of county commissioners shall not create any precinct that lies in more than one congressional district ~~[nor]~~ and shall ~~[the boards of county commissioners]~~ not divide any precinct so that the divided parts of the precinct are situated in two or more congressional districts. Votes cast in ~~[any general, primary or other]~~ a statewide election from precincts created or divided in violation of this subsection shall be invalid and shall not be counted or canvassed. "
