AN ACT

RELATING TO TAXATION OF CERTAIN MEDICAL AND HEALTH CARE SERVICES; AMENDING A SECTION OF THE NMSA 1978; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 7-9-77.1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1998, Chapter 96, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:

"7-9-77.1. DEDUCTION--GROSS RECEIPTS TAX--CERTAIN MEDICAL AND HEALTH CARE SERVICES.--

Receipts from payments by the United States government or any agency or agent thereof for provision of medical and other health services by medical doctors and [~~osteopaths~~] osteopathic physicians or of medical, other health and palliative services by a hospice to medicare beneficiaries pursuant to the provisions of Title [~~XVIII~~] 18
