16	Section 1. Section 2-3-14.1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1985,
17	Chapter 19, Section 1) is amended to read:
18	"2-3-14.1. STATE AGENCIESREPORTS[A.] No state
19	agency shall submit or send to the members of the legislature
20	any material, other than proposed legislation, in excess of
21	[five] <u>three</u> pages.
22	[B. Nothing in this section shall limit the
23	response of any agency to a direct request of a legislator or
24	group of legislators nor the submission of the executive
25	budget.

1	C. All reports to the legislature by a state
2	agency shall be filed in duplicate with the legislative
3	council service and such reports shall not be subject to the
4	page limitations of this section. The service shall compile a
5	list of the reports submitted prior to each regular
6	legislative session since the beginning of the previous
7	regular session, listing the title and agency and distribute
8	the list among the legislators during the first week of the
9	sessi on.
10	D. Any legislator may request any report,
11	including those listed pursuant to Subsection C of this
12	section. Upon such a request, the state agency shall furnish
13	the report to the legislator.
14	E. Compliance by a state agency with Subsection C
15	of this section shall fulfill any requirement of a state
16	agency to report to the legislature, unless the requirement is
17	specifically exempted from the requirements of this section.
18	F. No state agency shall submit material bound
19	other than by staples unless the bulk or other qualities of
20	the material require other bindings; provided that, in all
21	cases, the most economical method of binding and packaging
22	shall be used.
23	G.] For the purposes of this section, "state
24	agency" means any agency, division or instrumentality of the
