Section 8-3-3 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1971, Section 2. Chapter 138, Section 3, as amended) is amended to read:

**"8-3-3.** COMPENSATION. -- For the performance of the duties established in Section 8-3-1 NMSA 1978, the lieutenant governor shall receive an annual compensation of [sixty-five thousand dollars (\$65,000) ninety thousand dollars (\$90,000)."

Section 3. APPLICABILITY. -- The provisions of this act apply to elected state officers whose terms begin on or after January 1, 2003.
