AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION; REQUIRING THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC EDUCATION TO DEVELOP A TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE INDEX FOR PERSONNEL WHO ARE NOT ASSIGNED TO AN INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT; REQUIRING THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC EDUCATION TO REPORT ITS FINDINGS TO THE LEGISLATURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. TEMPORARY PROVISION--CLASSIFIED STAFF TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE INDEX--DEVELOPMENT--STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC EDUCATION.--

A. The state department of public education shall develop a classified staff training and experience index to be presented to and reviewed by the appropriate legislative interim committee prior to November 1, 2002.

B. For the purpose of calculating the classified

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1 staff training and experience index, the following definitions
2 and limitations shall apply:

3 (1) "classified staff" means personnel not
4 assigned to an instructional program of the school district;

5 (2) the number of classified staff to be
6 counted in calculating the classified staff training and
7 experience index is the actual number of full-time-equivalent
8 classified staff on the October payroll;

9 (3) the number of years of experience to be
10 used in calculating the classified staff training and
11 experience index is that number of years of experience allowed
12 for salary increment purposes on the salary schedule of the
13 school district; and

14 (4) the training and academic degree
15 component to be used in calculating the classified staff
16 training and experience index is the training and additional
17 degrees allowed for salary increment purposes of the salary
18 schedule of the school district.
