**FOR A REAUTHORIZATION TO CHANGE THE PURPOSE OF A SEVERANCE TAX BOND APPROPRIATION FOR PROJECTS IN UPPER FRUITLAND IN SAN JUAN COUNTY.**

The proceeds from the sale of severance tax bonds appropriated to the New Mexico office of Indian affairs pursuant to Subsection P of Section 12 of Chapter 7 of Laws 1998 and reauthorized in Subsection A of Section 127 of Chapter 23 of Laws 2000 (2nd S.S.) to pave the parking lot; purchase and install fencing and playground equipment; and furnish, equip and complete utility extensions and hook-ups for the early childhood program and in Subsection B of that section to extend a powerline to the Upper Fruitland subdivision shall not be expended for those purposes but are reauthorized and appropriated as follows:

A. sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) to renovate the chapter house in Upper Fruitland in San Juan county; and

B. forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) to purchase a truck for chapter use in Upper Fruitland in San Juan county.
