4 WHEREAS, the legislature has provided for similar  
5 analyses regarding other activities such as mining;

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE  
7 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the secretary of environment be  
8 requested to develop legislation that would require, prior to  
9 any formal action by the department of environment on new  
10 solid or hazardous waste facility permit applications:

11 A. an analysis of potential impacts of proposed  
12 waste disposal facilities on the environment, the economy and  
13 public services such as schools;

14 B. financing of emergency response services by the  
15 waste disposal facility operators; and

16 C. financial assurance for closure and post-  
17 closure care of the sites; and

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the secretary of environment  
19 present his findings and recommendations to the appropriate  
20 interim committee of the legislature by August 31, 2002; and

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be  
22 transmitted to the secretary of environment.
