17	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
18	Section 1. It is proposed to amend Article 20 of the

21	under any pretense for any purpose.
22	B. The governor shall not execute a future compact
23	for casino-style gaming or licensing of gaming operators.
24	C. For purposes of this section, "gaming" means:

4	(2) any form of a lottery."
5	Section 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution
6	shall be submitted to the people for their approval or
7	rejection at the next general election or at any special
8	election prior to that date that may be called for that
9	purpose.
10	Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATEThe effective date of the
11	provisions of Section 1 of this act, if approved by the people
12	at the next general election or at any special election prior
13	to that date, is January 1, 2003.
