19	the north central economic development district in conducting a
20	feasibility study of building a certified mobile livestock
	slaughter unit to serve small-scale livestock growers in rural
21	Rio Arriba county to enable them to market meat to local
22	markets in New Mexico. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance
23	remaining at the end of fiscal year 2004 shall revert to the
24	general fund.
