17	Section 1. Section 21-4-3 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1909,

22	A. The courses of [instuction] instruction at

24	(1) meet the needs of young people of New

(2) prepare technical and trade students for occupations and vocations [which] that are useful and necessary in the economy of New Mexico; and

(3) provide academic, technical and vocational instruction beyond the high school level and, in the event that the university of New Mexico northern branch is dissolved, may in addition [also] provide not more than two years of accredited college level academic instruction at those areas presently served by the university of New Mexico northern branch and by the northern New Mexico state school.

B. The <u>board of</u> regents [are] <u>of northern New</u>
<u>Mexico state school is</u> authorized to provide quarters for the boarding of resident students.

C. Nothing in this section shall preclude the university of New Mexico from continuing to provide upper college level and graduate courses in any areas in which such courses were being offered prior to January 1, 1977.

D. The board of regents of northern New Mexico state school is authorized to develop, implement and seek accreditation for a baccal aureate degree program in teacher education for the Espanola campus. No additional authorization from a state agency is required to permit the board of regents to fully implement the baccal aureate program it develops."
