AN ACT

RELATING TO THE FIRE PROTECTION FUND; PROVIDING THAT BALANCES IN THE FUND SHALL NOT REVERT OR BE TRANSFERRED TO THE GENERAL FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 59A-53-15 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1984, Chapter 127, Section 986, as amended) is amended to read:

"59A-53-15. APPROPRIATION FROM STATE TREASURY.--All money which from time to time is deposited in the state treasury and credited to the fire protection fund is appropriated to the [corporation] public regulation commission for the use of the marshal for the purposes set out in Chapter 59A, Article 53 NMSA 1978 and shall be distributed by the state treasurer and expended as provided in that article. [Hereafter, all sums in excess of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for pro rata
