

HOUSE JOINT MEMORIAL 69

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A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE FUNDING FORMULA STUDY TASK FORCE TO INCLUDE VIRTUAL SCHOOLS, DISTANCE EDUCATION AND OTHER ONLINE EDUCATION PROGRAMMING IN THE FUNDING FORMULA STUDY REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS; URGING LEGISLATIVE AND EXECUTIVE SUPPORT FOR THE USE OF THIS IMPORTANT EDUCATIONAL RESOURCE, PARTICULARLY FOR RURAL AND SMALLER SCHOOL DISTRICTS.

WHEREAS, educational programs that allow students to learn any subject anytime, anywhere and at any place are known by several names, including virtual school, distance education, internet-based education, cybereducation or e-education; and

WHEREAS, the public education department distinguishes the three major categories of online education as follows:

- (1) virtual schools are those that offer online education that replicates all of the functions carried out by

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1 traditional bricks and mortar schools, and courses may be  
2 synchronous or asynchronous;

3 (2) distance education is a strategy that delivers  
4 select courses in a traditional school setting; and

5 (3) internet-based education is the broadest  
6 category in that it may include instructor-led courses  
7 typically found in distance education or may include web sites  
8 specifically intended to present problem-based learning, and  
9 traditional schools often use this approach as a means of  
10 integrating technology with a curriculum by assigning research  
11 or writing tasks that rely on internet information sources; and

12 WHEREAS, each category uses technology to deliver five key  
13 processes of learning, to wit, instruction, assessment,  
14 prescription, intervention and performance data management; and

15 WHEREAS, these online educational tools are particularly  
16 important for students in rural areas because they are the  
17 means to provide educational opportunities by qualified  
18 instructors that a small school district may not be able to  
19 offer with current staff; and

20 WHEREAS, online education can be an efficient and cost-  
21 effective way to deliver quality education and a much broader  
22 academic program to New Mexico public school students; and

23 WHEREAS, the public school funding formula has not kept  
24 pace with the advances in education through online resources;  
25 and

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1           WHEREAS, as the funding formula study task force prepares  
2 the request for proposals for a comprehensive study of the  
3 formula, it is imperative that it include this vital  
4 educational resource in the study in order to determine  
5 adequate funding for online educational opportunities for  
6 children;

7           NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE  
8 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the funding formula study task force  
9 be requested to study costs and funding for online education  
10 and be urged to include funding for online education in any  
11 proposed funding formula; and

12           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the legislature be urged to  
13 pay a portion of the costs to provide online education in rural  
14 and smaller school districts this year and next year outside  
15 the funding formula; and

16           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the public education  
17 department be urged to support online education appropriations  
18 and assist school districts in selecting online education  
19 programming that meets or exceeds statewide academic standards  
20 and that takes into account the special techniques of course  
21 design, special instructional techniques, special methods of  
22 communication by electronic and other technology as well as the  
23 special organizational and administrative arrangements needed  
24 for a successful online educational offering; and

25           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be

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1 transmitted to the funding formula study task force and the  
2 public education department.

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
